- Location:** Villanueva de Duero (Valladolid) - Spain
- Age of vines:** Own vineyards over 20 years of age
- Yield:** 7.500 Kg/Ha
- Plantation system:** Pruned (Cordon Royat system)
- Soils:** Mainly stony, clayey-sandy, with thick elements and limestone present in the subsoil, which gives strong balsamic notes.
- Vineyard altitude:** 685 meters
- Climate:** Mediterranean due to its location and Continental due to its altitude. The temperature gap between the day and night, is the secret to reach the optimal levels of sugar and acidity.
- Rainfall:** 300-400 mm
- Average temperature:** 12.4°C
- Harvest:** Mechanical night harvest
- Harvest Period:** Mid September
- Elaboration:** Integral management of the vineyards under the strictest quality criteria. Integrated viticulture with the natural environment. Stony soil where quality is a must, implementing green pruning to get lower yields per Ha. in a process where the quality is first versus quantity. Night harvest.
- Ageing:** No
- Grape Variety:** Verdejo
- Alcohol:** 13%
- Production:** 30.000 bottles
- Tasting Notes:** Pale yellow straw colour, very clean and bright. On the nose notes of tropical and bone fruits. Very fruity and intense on the palate, with volume, soft and creamy. Nice entry and balanced acidity.
